### Why Study History?

The main aim is to not only promote knowledge of recent world history but to learn valuable lessons for the future.


The study of world history from 1919 to the present day follows two main themes:-

#### **International Relations 1919 – 1939**

Examines the search for international order between 1919 to 1930 and the collapse of this order in the 1930's.

#### **Tension and Cooperation since 1945**

Two superpowers of the USA and USSR and the effects of this on other regions – notably Europe. Events in Korea, Congo and Vietnam – especially UN involvement.

 In addition, students complete two depth studies which vary every two years.

### What's involved?

#### **Examinations (100%)**

All candidates will take three papers:-

Paper 1 – core option and depth studies;

Paper 2 – questions based on specified source material

Paper 4 – alternative to coursework.

Pass grades A\* to G are awarded on successful completion of exams.
