# Beginning and End of the Day

This year as usual we will offer an early drop off time from **7:45am**. Students should be left with Mr. Borges at the Foundation Stage patio entrance.

**Students in Foundation 1 to Year 9:** Please note that the gate of the **Junior school** will close this year at **8:40am.** Those who arrive between 8:40am and 8:50 am should enter at **8:50am through the same door**, but they will be marked as late for the school registration.

**Students in Year 10 and above:** The **Senior school** will be open from **8:00am** every morning and the gate will close this year at **8:40am.** Those who arrive between 8:40am and 8:50 am should enter at **8:50am through the same door**, but they will be marked as late for the school registration.

Any child arriving after 8:50am should be brought to Administration and the late register must be signed by a parent. The child will then be taken to class as soon as a member of staff is available.

Please inform the school via email if your child is late for a medical or any other justifiable reason.

School finish times will continue to be staggered and arranged to facilitate parking.

Years 9, 10 and 11 will leave at 3.10 pm via the Sixth Form building.

Years 12 and 13 leave at 2.50 pm if staying for lunch or 2.20 pm if not, via the Sixth Form building
